PannErgy Plc's support within the context of social responsibility

In line with its earlier decisions made for social responsibility causes, PannErgy Plc's management has decided to support the creation of the musical tale production entitled 'Fallen Tree' to be staged with the contribution of the students of the Elementary Institution for Arts Education, Kodály Zoltán Music Primary School, High School and Music School of Budapest in the form of funding this year.

Following the well-established practices of the earlier years, towards the environmentally conscious education of children PannErgy Plc management is supporting the creation of the live musical tale production entitled 'Fallen Tree' in the form of funding.

The play initiated by the parents of the nearly 30 students participating in the production and to be staged with their voluntary contributions is about nature where the songs of Vilmos Gryllus and Anita Németh linked up into a story will be accompanied by the authors' live musical performance.

The story focuses on the emotional relationship of children, animals and plants by conveying the messages of love for our environment, acceptance, mutual help, critical approach and sustainability in a manner that is comprehensible, enjoyable and touching for children. In the play, the Old Oak offering home for the animals falls in a storm, but children plant a small tree by the Oak so that it should not be alone, and on the other hand let the forest live on.

The premiere of the play is scheduled to be held on 14 June 2012 in the Marczibányi Square Community Center, and after the performance the children (with the assistance of two parents working as gardeners) will plant a small tree in the garden of Kodály Zoltán Music School.

With this tree planted, the makers of the production want to set up a memento for this exemplary initiative based on voluntary participation, collaboration, the pleasure of joint creation, the love for music and the environment, familiarization with all these values, mutual acceptance and affection.

For our company, it is of high significance to shepherd young people towards the protection of the environment and environmentally conscious attitude in their childhood, with reliance on playful methods, such as the musical production entitled 'Fallen Tree'.
