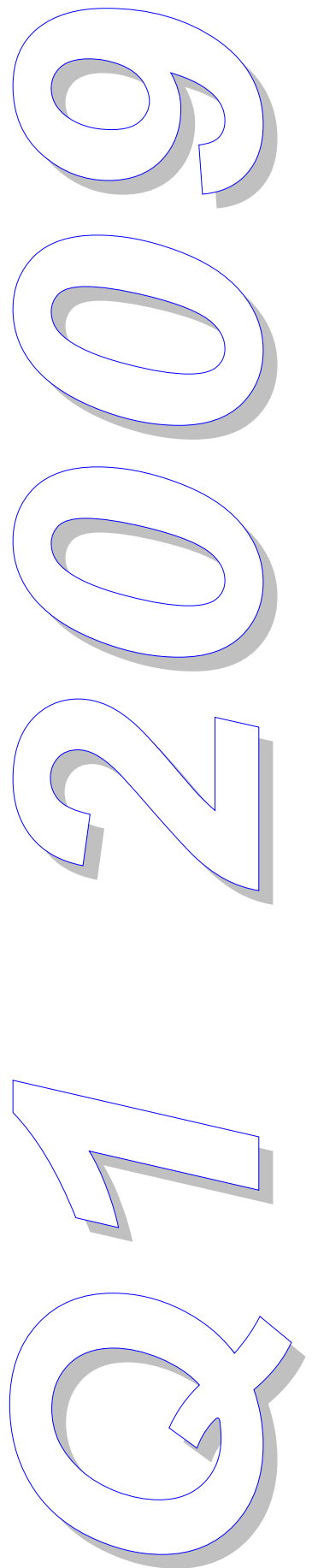




PannErgy Plc's Interim Management Report

Q1 of 2009

15 May 2009



This interim report includes the consolidated, non-audited data of PannErgy Group prepared in conformance with the principles of the International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS)

The first well drilling has been started, and additional actions for the identification of well locations and drilling preparations have been continued

The profit of the quarter has been dominated by financial losses primarily caused by the weakening of the Hungarian forint against the euro exceeding HUF 310 due to the revaluation of the foreign currency loan volume of Pannunion Group

Although in comparison with the preceding periods more moderate, still considerable financial losses have been suffered on Synergon share investments and PannErgy futures share positions, in a total amount of HUF 250 million

Steady growth of operating profit and cash flow at Pannunion Group, as well as considerably improving profit rates

Beside general operating items, the periodic results of the Group were impacted by the 16% drop of the rate of Synergon shares and the 15% decrease of PannErgy's relevant futures rates. These latter two items caused a total loss of approximately HUF 250 million. The other significant, also financial impact was the nearly HUF 250 million gain on foreign currency assets (in fact, the hedging of Pannunion's exposure in liabilities) due to the weakening of the Hungarian forint. The quarter did not witness any non-recurrent, materially positive item.

In the field of geothermal energy exploitation, the municipal contract portfolio having been concluded so far reached the volume targeted towards the accomplishment of our strategic objectives – no additional growth was seen during the quarter. On the basis of our examinations, we continued to identify those locations for the establishment of wells that offered the best endowments. The drilling of the first well was launched in Szentlőrinc, while in Tamási preparations were made for the preliminary phase of drilling.

The energetic business line (including asset management activities) has relied on HUF 90 million costs.

In the case of the property of PMM Zrt. in Székesfehérvár, the formerly established leasing scheme has been continued with steady income received. The present value of the leasing has been revaluated with respect to the EUR/HUF exchange rates and currently effective interest-rate levels with an approximately 200 million profit improving impact.

Synergon Plc is not involved in the scope of consolidation (a 13 % voting right as of the accounting date). Consequently, this investment is accounted for at the associated stock-exchange price.

Summary extract of Pannunion Plc's stock-exchange flash report

The periodic performance of the Group improved considerably in comparison with the base period. In the first quarter of the year, the additional weakening of the Hungarian forint against the euro (the average exchange rate in the quarter was 294.57 HUF/€) had positive influence on the export turnover and profit rate of the Group. The low level of base material prices also improved the operating profit of the Group. The ordering portfolio of the Group was steady with some minor increase. Besides the weakening of the Hungarian forint, considerable financial losses were suffered on the up-valuation of the large EUR-based loan volume. The interest payables of Pannunion further increased in the first quarter due to the additional rise of interest margins. The operating profit and business cash flow of the Group saw remarkable growth. Except for the Ukrainian Interagropack, the volumes of sales of all the Group entities increased in comparison with the base period (in kg and quantities). The Romanian Unical experienced the largest growth in EBITDA, yet the extent of increase was over 39% at each of the members as compared of the base

period. Low base material prices were passed over to the selling prices just partly owing to the applied method of pricing with the price following period being 2–3 months. At the Serbian Unionplast, production and sales activities were launched in Q3 of 2008. Unionplast's EBITDA value was first positive in Q1 of 2009.

2. Financial analysis

2.1. Profit and loss account

The Company's consolidated sales revenues totaled up to HUF 3,102 million in the period under review, which is 16.7% smaller than in the same period of the previous year. The principal reason of the decrease was the gross settlement of the sales transaction concerning the FCI business share over the gross profit rate of the base period.

The level of direct costs dropped in excess of the rate of decrease in sales revenues, by 23.1%. Similarly to sales trends, the corresponding volume was influenced by the considerable decrease of the direct costs of the FCI transaction and Pannunion Group.

The indirect costs of sales amounted to HUF 693 million in the period under review; this amount represented 22.3% of sales revenues and 104.8% of the corresponding value in the base period. The primary reason of increase was the growing costs of Pannunion Group. The full-time employee headcount of the Group was reduced from the 617 base value to 585 employees as a consequence of the headcount rationalization move at Pannunion Group.

The balance of other expenditures and incomes in the period under review was HUF 76 million expenditure in comparison with the HUF 106 million income of the base period.

The operating profit (EBIT) was HUF 95 million in the period under review, whereas the base period had witnessed HUF 257 million loss. After the elimination of the non-recurrent positive items of the base period (approximately HUF 400 million), some improvement could be seen.

The operating cash flow (EBITDA) was HUF 383 million, which was HUF 145 million under the corresponding value in the base period, but when it was modified with the above-mentioned non-recurrent items of the base period, considerable improvement could be seen. The period under review brought about depreciation in a total amount of HUF 288 million, which was HUF 17 million over the base value. The underlying reason was the investment activities realized approximately on the actual level of depreciation.

Financial operations resulted in HUF 604 million loss in the period under review, which was HUF 255 million less favourable than the value in the same period of 2008. The material items in this loss included interest expenses, exchange losses on foreign currency based loans, the drop in rates of Synergon shares and PannErgy futures positions.

The result of ordinary activities came to be HUF 509 million loss, which was more moderate than the HUF 602 million negative performance in the base period.

The Company had no extraordinary profit or material tax payment liabilities.

The consolidated net profit was in fact HUF 481 million loss due to the above-described reasons, which proved to be more favourable than the HUF 599 million negative result in the base period.

2.2. Balance sheet

The volume of intangible assets increased by HUF 453 million in comparison with the base value, which covered geothermal research works.

Financial investments included the real-estate property of PMM Zrt. leased out in Székesfehérvár.

The drop of the volume of current assets resulted from the combined effect of the decrease of cash and similar assets, securities, as well as the increase of receivables. The volume of inventories remained steady.

The Company's equity decreased as a consequence of losses in the period under review and the preceding periods. The value of the equity per share dropped to HUF 515 (base value: HUF 629).

The increase of the loan volume was primarily driven by the up-valuation of the foreign currency based loans of Pannunion Group due to the weakening Hungarian forint. The net loan volume rose to HUF 5,273 million. The net loan/ equity ratio increased to 0.54.

The balance of other short-term liabilities came to be over the level of the base value. Material increasing items included the VAT amount of the selling of real-estate properties, the non-realized losses on forward transactions and leasing liabilities.

2.3. Cash- low

The liquid assets from operations reflected a significant, HUF 472 million in-flow. The most important item of other adjustment was the correction of foreign currency losses that did not influence cash flow.

The amount of new net capital expenditures and investments was a HUF 631 million outgoing cash flow.

The cash flow of financing activities was HUF 268 million received.

In comparison with the base period, the cash and security portfolio of the Group shrank, mostly due to the financial losses described above.

3. Miscellaneous

3.1. Deferred taxes

The Company has not accounted for HUF 252 million deferred income from tax for reasons of diligence. The 16 % corporate income tax rate has been applied to tax calculation.

3.2. Corporate events

On 29 April 2009, the Company held its Ordinary Annual General Meeting. Resolutions by the General Meeting have been published via the official media of disclosure.

3.3. Employees

The closing headcount of the Group's own employees was 585 at the beginning of the quarter under review, identical with the closing volume at the end of the period.

From the total headcount, 138 employees are engaged by our foreign group entities.

The number of such employees in lease work is still insignificant on the group level.

3.4. Changes in the Company's share capital, management and organization

As of 31 December 2008, the share capital amounted to HUF 421,093,100, which still has not change during 2009. In the financial statements, the Company's share capital (only base period) and the number of shares have been recorded as deducting the par values and volumes of treasury shares having been repurchased.

As of 31 March 2009, the Company held 2,126,203 PannErgy Plc shares and stock-exchange futures purchase contracts for such 1,197,500 shares. The futures contracts have their expirations in June 2009.

As of 31 March 2009, PannErgy Plc holds open, American sold call option for 200,000 shares.

Information as concerning senior officers is detailed in Data Sheet TSZ3.

3.5. Major events after the balance sheet date

After the balance sheet date and before the publication of the report, there were no such material events that were not stated in this section or the other parts of this interim management report.

In accordance with the related legal regulations, we hereby declare that this Report does not present any material errors that would cause this quarterly stock-exchange flash report to reflect any unrealistic view on the Company's asset, financial and income status as of 31 March 2009.
