Announcement of the results of the national art competition

The national art competition announced by PannErgy Plc on 26 March 2014 under the title of "Geothermal energy – Part of our Lives" for primary school pupils has now been concluded with the evaluation of the nearly 200 creations by the jury. The jury has been in an extremely difficult situation to make its decision, because the competitive works of both junior and senior pupils have proved to be highly creative and resourceful pieces of art demonstrating what geothermal energy means for kids, and how they imagine its utilization.

Based on the jury's decision, the two first-ranking creations:

Competitive work of art winning the junior pupil category:

Joint creation of the first-year group of Bálint Sándor Divisional School, Petőfi Sándor Primary School of Szeged

Competitive work of art winning the senior pupil category:

Kiara Korcsog, 14 years of age, pupil of Class 8.b, Petőfi István Primary School, Elementary School of Arts and Boarding School of Kondoros

With their classes, the two first-ranking contenders have been awarded with a visit to the District Heating Center of Kistokaj belonging to the Geothermal Project of Miskolc, where in the framework of a special presentation the pupils can "walk the way" of geothermal energy from exploitation to use and reinjection back to the ground.

Furthermore, the jury has given special awards to the best three creations of both the junior and senior pupil categories.
