PannErgy Group involved in tree replacement works in Győr

PannErgy Plc's subsidiary, DD Energy Production and Services Ltd has commenced tree replacement works in Győr in order to restore the vegetation cleared off for the construction of the transmission line of the Geothermal Project of Győr. At various locations in the city of Győr, altogether 454 ornamental trees are set to be planted.

Because of the construction works of the transmission line for the Geothermal Project of Győr, the Company had to fell some 85 trees in public spaces along a route of approximately 17 km. After detailed consultation with GYŐR-SZOL Győr Public Services and Assets Management Ltd, it was determined in which areas of the city of Győr new trees were to be planted in order to improve the cityscape in the best possible manner. Today, gardening works have been commenced at several locations. According to the tree replacement plan, altogether 454 trees of significant ornamental values (globe Norway maple, globe cherry, 'Fastigiata' European hornbeam, globe locust) will be used for the restoration of vegetation at priority sites.

"PannErgy Group has always had a strong focus on safeguarding the environment and the full-scale remediation of any damage that may have been caused. Commenced today, its activities to plant ornamental trees have been undertaken to contribute to adding to green spaces in the city of Győr and preserving the fragile harmony of living in urban spaces."—Balázs Bokorovics, the Chairman of PannErgy Plc's Board of Directors declared.
