Outstanding daily heat sales as an outcome of the investment program

Owing to investment program for the capacity expansion of the geothermal systems operated by PannErgy Group in Győr, on 7 November 2016 the combined volume of heat delivered from the Miskolc and Győr system to the contracted partners was 6950 GJ (the highest daily volume of heat sales so far was 6488 GJ).

In the framework of the capacity expansion investment program in Győr, following several months of preparative works a geothermal well pump featuring uniquely high capacity was successfully incorporated in the BON-PE-02 production well of Bőny. Following its commissioning in October, the ESP pump system designed specifically for geothermal systems was subjected to several weeks of trial runs and continuous operating test, during which the primary side regulating program was modified in order to ensure fully smooth, consistent normal operation. The testing experience shows that the operation of the pump is sufficiently safe and reliable, while the production capacity of the BON-PE-02 well has increased to 600-610 m³/h, i.e. with the two production wells more than 955 m³/h capacity can be achieved.

"The heat selling figures targeted by the capacity expansion program have been successfully reached by our geothermal systems. Green heat sales in a daily average volume of 6700 – 6950 GJ is strongly supported by the given temperature conditions, when the outdoor temperature remains in the range between +1 and +7 degrees Celsius, because in view of the particular characteristics of the Geothermal System of Miskolc and Győr these systems can sustain maximum capacities under such weather circumstances. The measured data and performed analyses have confirmed our preliminary calculations, and promise that in the heating season of 2016-2017 our geothermal systems in Győr and Miskolc will reach the monthly 200-210 000 GJ input volume of green heat in the November-March period of the heating season." – stated Balázs Bokorovics, Chairman of PannErgy Plc's Board of Directors.
